

■ Number of International Students ● Percent Increase from Prior Year





- ▶ According to data from the China Scholarship Council and Project Atlas, international enrollments more than doubled from 2007 to 2015.

► China's outbound tourism has experienced remarkable changes over the past decade. The volume of international trips by Chinese travelers grew from **10 million** in 2000 to nearly **100 million** in 2013, the biggest jump of any country in the world.



Introduction of CI at the University of Wrocław

- ▶ Based on the agreement between Hanban and the University of Wrocław signed on 11 December 2007, the Confucius Institute at the University of Wrocław began enrolling students and started teaching Chinese on October 5, 2008. The official inauguration was on 2, December 2008.
- ▶ At present, the institute has 5 Chinese teachers and 7 volunteer Chinese teachers, 4 office staff and 3 part-time teachers employed from Poland. In 2015, the total number of Chinese learners in and outside the institute is 800, increasing by 10.5% compared with that of 2014.

Stypendium Magisterskie

Scholarship for Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese
to Speakers of Other Languages (MTCSOL) Students

- ▶ Stypendium obejmuje **dwa lata akademickie**

Aplikujący powinien:

- ▶ Posiadać stopień licencjata lub jego ekwiwalent
- ▶ **Stypendium pełne:** Wymagania: co najmniej 210 punktów z egzaminu **HSK 5** + certyfikat **HSKK** poziom średniozaawansowany
- ▶ **Stypendium częściowe:** Wymagania: co najmniej 180 punktów z egzaminu **HSK 5** + certyfikat **HSKK** poziom średniozaawansowany

Stypendium Licencjackie BTCSOL

Scholarship for Bachelor's Degree in Teaching Chinese
to Speakers of Other Languages (BTCSOL) Students

- ▶ Stypendium obejmuje **cztery lata akademickie**.

Aplikujący powinien:

- ▶ posiadać dyplom ukończenia szkoły średniej lub dyplom ukończenia uczelni wyższej.
- ▶ **Stypendium pełne:** wymagania: co najmniej 210 punktów z egzaminu **HSK 4** + certyfikat **HSKK** poziom średniozaawansowany
- ▶ **Stypendium częściowe:** wymagania: co najmniej 180 punktów z egzaminu **HSK 4** + certyfikat **HSKK** poziom średniozaawansowany

Stypendium Roczne

Scholarship for One-Academic-Year Study Students

Stypendium przeznaczone jest dla studentów Instytutu Konfucjusza, zagranicznych nauczycieli języka chińskiego, studentów sinologii, osób z wysokimi wynikami egzaminu HSK.

- ▶ Stypendium obejmuje **jeden rok akademicki (11 miesięcy)**.
- ▶ Aplikujący, chcący studiować na kierunku **Nauczanie języka chińskiego jako obcego** powinien:
 - ▶ Otrzymać co najmniej 270 punktów z egzaminu **HSK 3** + certyfikat **HSKK**.
 - ▶ Beneficjentom tego rodzaju stypendium przysługiwać będzie stypendium pełne.
- ▶ Aplikujący chcący uczyć się na kierunku **Literatura chińska, Historia Chin i Filozofia chińska poziom zaawansowany** powinien :
 - ▶ Otrzymać co najmniej 180 punktów z egzaminu **HSK 4** + certyfikat **HSKK** poziom średniozaawansowany.
 - ▶ O przyznaniu stypendium pełnego lub częściowego decydować będzie narodowość, kolejność rejestracji oraz poziom znajomości języka chińskiego.

Stypendium Semestralne

Scholarship for One-Semester Study Students

- ▶ Stypendium jest przeznaczone dla osób, które wcześniej nie studiowały w Chinach.
- ▶ Stypendium obejmuje jeden **semestr akademicki (5 miesięcy)**

Aplikujący, chcący studiować na kierunku **Nauczanie języka chińskiego jako obcego** powinien:

- ▶ Otrzymać co najmniej 210 punktów z egzaminu HSK 3 + certyfikat HSKK poziom podstawowy

Aplikujący chcący uczyć się na kierunku **Medycyna chińska/Kultura Taiji** powinien:

- ▶ Przedstawić swoje wyniki z egzaminu HSK

Aplikujący chcący uczyć się na kierunku **Literatura chińska, Historia Chin i Filozofia chińska** powinien:

- ▶ Otrzymać co najmniej 210 punktów z egzaminu HSK 3 + certyfikat HSKK poziom podstawowy.

Stypendium 4-tygodniowe

Scholarship for Four-Week Study Students

- ▶ Stypendium przeznaczone przede wszystkim dla studentów Instytutu Konfucjusza, osób z wysokimi wynikami egzaminu HSK, wyróżniających się uczniów Instytutu Konfucjusza, którzy wcześniej nie studiowali w Chinach.

Aplikujący powinien:

- ▶ Mieć zdany egzamin HSK
- ▶ Nauczyciele języka chińskiego mogą aplikować na kurs **Nauczanie języka chińskiego jako obcego**.
- ▶ Kursanci Instytutu Konfucjusza i nauczyciele chińskiego mają możliwość aplikowania na kursy **Medycyna chińska** lub **Kultura Taiji**.
- ▶ Grupy kursantów Instytutu Konfucjusza (nie więcej niż 10-15 osób) mogą aplikować kurs „**Język chiński i chińska rodzina w praktyce**.”

Stypendia Rządu Chińskiego

Chinese Government Scholarships



- ▶ Aplikacje: styczeń – początek kwietnia
(w zależności od uniwersytetu)
- ▶ Wyniki: lipiec
- ▶ Programy:
 - ▶ Bilateral program (degree programs and non-degree programs)
 - ▶ Chinese University program (graduate programs)
 - ▶ Great Wall Program (non-degree programs)
 - ▶ EU Program (degree programs and non-degree programs)


Chinese Government Scholarships

- ▶ Kierunki studiów: oferowane przez uniwersytety biorące udział w programie (252 uniwersytetów wybranych przez Chińskie Ministerstwo Edukacji)
- ▶ Język wykładowy: chiński lub angielski
- ▶ Możliwość aplikacji na parę programów jednocześnie
- ▶ Confucius Institute can offer you a recommendation letter for your application

- ▶ **Słypendium lokalnego Uniwersytetu**

Summer Camp and Winter Camp

■ Program Introduction

Chinese Bridge Summer Camp for Secondary School Students is an annual Chinese language and culture experiencing activity sponsored by Hanban with the cooperation of the Confucius Institutes over the world.

■ Contents

Chinese Bridge Summer Camp for Secondary School Students provides students with Chinese language, culture classes (such as paper cutting, calligraphy, ink and wash painting, tea ceremony, and martial arts), rich and varied activities (get together with Chinese students, home-stay experiences, etc.) and cultural experiencing activities.

■ Fees

Students must pay for their own international airfare and visa and must buy international medical insurance. Hanban is responsible for covering the costs of students and accompanying teachers' food and lodging, transportation, and group activities while in China.



International Conference Grant

► Purpose

The International Conference Grant is aimed at supporting Confucius Institutes, universities, research institutes, and scholars to hold or attend international academic conferences on Sinology and/or China Studies.

► Funding

- ▶ The accommodation and travel expenses of conference speakers;
- ▶ Registration fees;
- ▶ Publication fees of conference proceedings.

Young Leaders Fellowship

► Purpose

- 1) Support outstanding youths who have been awarded at least a Bachelor's Degree and hold a certain position in the field of politics, economics, finance, law, education, culture, arts, and media to visit China;
- 2) There are two ways in applying for the grant:
 - (1) a plan will be made by the Headquarters and published at due time through www.hanban.org and ccsp.chinese.cn, applicants can apply accordingly;
 - (2) applicants can make their own visit plan and submit it to the Headquarters;
- 3) Support senior undergraduates or graduates holding a position in students' associations at foreign universities to visit China.

► Duration

From two weeks to six months.

► Funding

- Accommodation and travel expenses in China
- Round-trip international airfare
- Life insurance during the visit term in China

“Understanding China” Fellowship

► Purpose and Eligibility

This program serves to support teachers, researchers, postdoctoral scholars with the credential of assistant professor (or equivalent) and above from foreign universities and academic institutes to undertake research with Chinese researchers in China.

Applicants shall be non-Chinese citizens.

► Duration

From two weeks to six months.

► Funding

- 10000 RMB per month;
- Round-trip international airfare (economy class, to be reimbursed against actual cost);
- Life insurance during the visit term in China (We will buy for you; reimbursement is not applicable.)

“Understanding China” Short-term Visit

► Purpose

The “Understanding China” Short-term Visit program serves to support senior officials from government, education and culture, non-governmental organizations and business.

► Duration

From two weeks to two months.

► Funding

- Accommodation and travel expenses in China;
- Round-trip international airfare (economy class, to be reimbursed against actual cost);
- Life insurance during the visit term in China (We will buy for you; reimbursement is not applicable.)

Joint Research Ph.D. Fellowship

- ▶ **Purpose :**

Support doctoral students (candidates) registered with foreign universities to come to China for study, research and writing of their doctoral dissertations.

- ▶ **Duration:** From six months to two years.

- ▶ **Eligibility**

- ▶ Non-Chinese citizen;
- ▶ HSK test score level 3 is required;

- ▶ **Funding:**

- ▶ Lodging and living stipend: 80,000 RMB per year
- ▶ Research fund: 20,000 RMB per year
- ▶ Round-trip international airfare
- ▶ Tuition
- ▶ Other support provided by the host Chinese university
- ▶ Expenses for the foreign supervisor's visit or research in China
- ▶ Expenses for life and medical insurances in China

Ph.D. in China Fellowship

- ▶ **Purpose:** Support foreign students to pursue full-time Ph.D. degrees in the humanities and social sciences at Chinese universities.
- ▶ **Eligibility:**
 - ▶ Non-Chinese citizen;
 - ▶ HSK test score level 5 is required, and priority is given to applicants with higher level of proficiency in Chinese under same conditions;
- ▶ **Funding:**
 - ▶ Lodging and living stipend: 80,000 RMB per year
 - ▶ Research fund: 20,000 RMB per year
 - ▶ Round-trip international airfare;
 - ▶ Tuition
 - ▶ Other support provided by the host Chinese university
 - ▶ Expenses for life and medical insurances in China.




Publication Grant

► Purpose

Publication Grant supports foreign scholars to publish or translate relevant monograph, doctoral dissertations, or founding relevant academic journals in Sinology and/or China Studies.

► Funding

The grant covers expenses for editing, translation, publication, circulation and advertising. The exact expenses will be approved according to the application.
